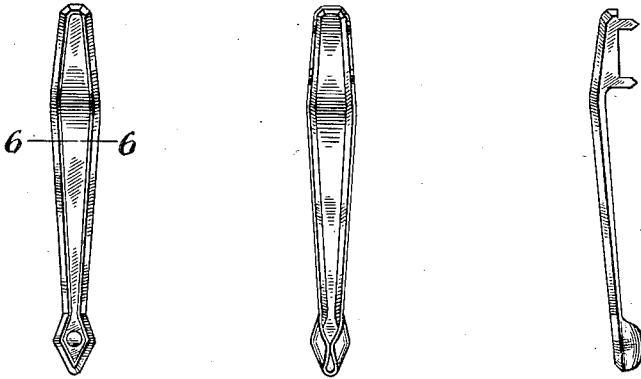

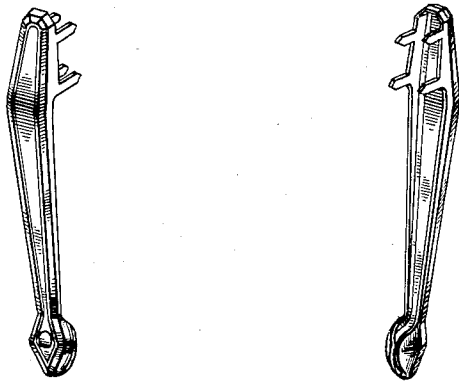

## DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN AND PENCIL CLIP

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, David Kahn, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen and Pencil Clip, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:—

Figure 1 is a front elevation of the clip.

Figure 2 is a rear elevation.

Figure 3 is a side view.

Figure 4 is a front perspective of the clip.

Figure 5 is a rear perspective of the clip.

Figure 6 is a cross section taken on the line 6—6 of Figure 1.
