

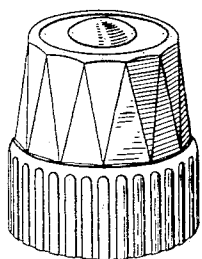

DESIGN FOR AN INK BOTTLE CAP
