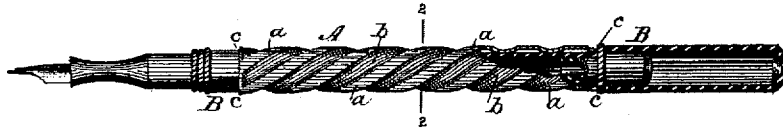

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN-PEN OR PENCIL HOLDER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 19,277, dated August 20, 1889.

Application filed July 10, 1889. Serial No. 317,053. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWARD TODD, Jr., a
citizen of the United States, residing at New
York, in the county of New York and State
5 of New York, have invented and produced a
new and original Design for Fountain-Pen
Holders and Pencils; and I do hereby declare
the following to be a full, clear, and exact de-
10 scription of the same, reference being had to
the accompanying drawings, forming a part
thereof.

Figure 1 is a side view, partly in section, of
a fountain-pen holder showing my design.
15 Fig. 2 is a transverse section of the same, cut
through line 2 2 of Fig. 1; and Fig. 3 is a side
view of a pencil-holder also showing my de-
sign.

The salient feature of my design consists

in a raised spiral or spiral-flanged sleeve or
jacket, the outer surface being patterned to
partially simulate the flanged surface of a
gimlet or auger.

The sleeve or jacket A surrounds the body
B of a fountain-pen or a pencil, and is pro-
vided with triple flanges or threads *a*, sepa-
rated from each other by U-shaped grooves
b, as shown in the sectional portion of Fig. 1.

What I claim is—

The design for a fountain-pen or pencil
holder herein shown.
