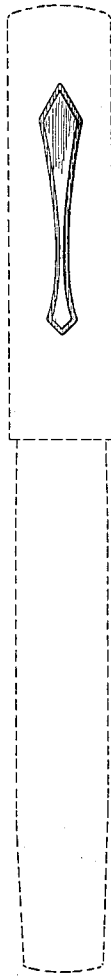
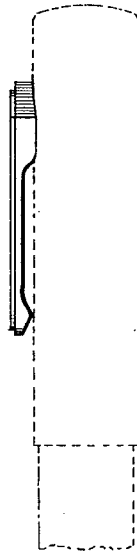

DESIGN FOR A CLIP FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR THE LIKE

Application filed September 21, 1929. Serial No. 32,821. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GABRIEL LARSEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Clip for a Fountain Pen or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a clip for a fountain pen, showing my new design; and Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the same, the broken lines merely showing how the design would appear when in use on a conventional fountain pen.
