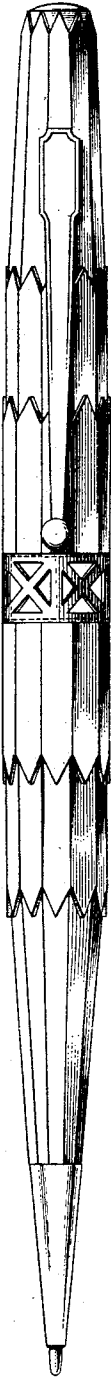

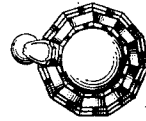

DESIGN FOR A PENCIL

Application filed May 24, 1932. Serial No. 43,891. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID KAHN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Woodcliff, in the county of Hudson, and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pencil, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein—
