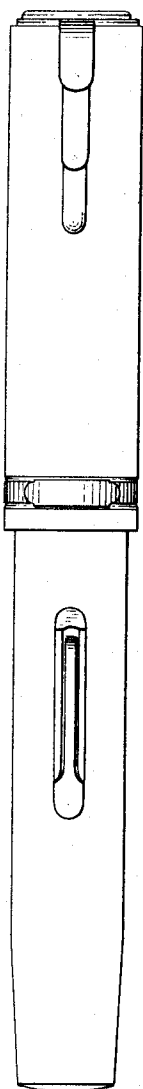
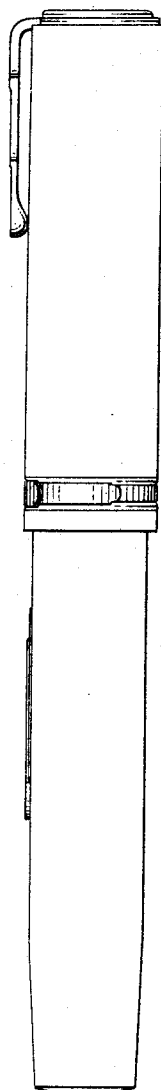

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed February 3, 1931. Serial No. 38,537. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GABRIEL LARSEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pens or Similar Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figs. 1 and 2 are longitudinal views of a pen embodying the invention, these views being taken at right angles to each other.
