

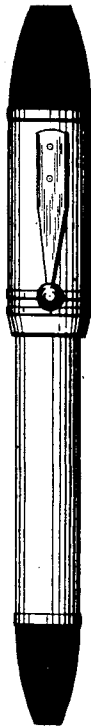

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed April 4, 1930. Serial No. 35,159. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, LOUIS MORRISON, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at New York city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof, in which the figure is a front view in elevation of a fountain pen or similar article showing my new design.

The design consists in the ornamental bands placed equidistant from either end of the fountain pen; the contrasting colors at either end of the fountain pen, and the cut off ends of the fountain pen.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or similar article as shown and described.
