

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Warren Green and Peter Schladermundt, both citizens of the United States, residing in Noroton Heights, county of Fairfield, and State of Connecticut, and Bronxville, county of Westchester, and State of New York, respectively, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing our design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the pen; and Fig. 3 is a rear elevational view of the pen.

In the accompanying drawing the characteristic features of our design are shown in full line. We claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
