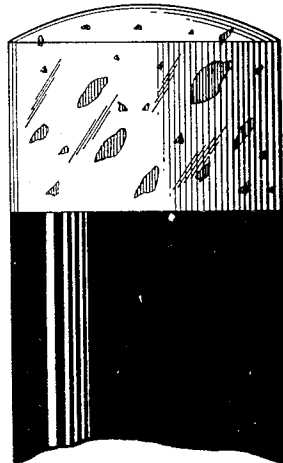

SAMUEL V. CORONA, OF JANESVILLE, WISCONSIN.

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN.

Application filed December 16, 1922. Serial No. 4,623. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL V. CORONA, a citizen of the United States, residing at Janesville, in the county of Rock and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a fountain pen showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary side view thereof.

My ornamental and original design for fountain pens includes as an important feature the cap piece on the end of the cap which is made of any suitable transparent material and has flakes of gold leaf embedded therein.
