

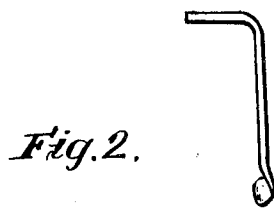
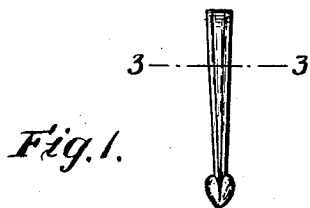

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SETH CHILTON CROCKER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pocket Clip for Pens, Pencils and the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Figs. 1 and 2 are views in front and side elevation, respectively, and

Fig. 3 is a cross sectional view, on an enlarged scale, at line 3—3 of Fig. 1, of a pocket clip for pens, pencils and the like, showing my new design.
