To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CRAIG R. SHEAFFER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a front elevational view of a fountain pen or similar article showing my new design, the surface embellishment consisting of

inlaid fragmentary faceted pieces of mother-of-pearl terminating a substantial distance from each end of the instrument.

It is understood that my design may be embodied in such articles as a fountain pen, pencil or combination fountain pen and pencil without departing from the spirit of my invention.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or similar article substantially as shown and described.
