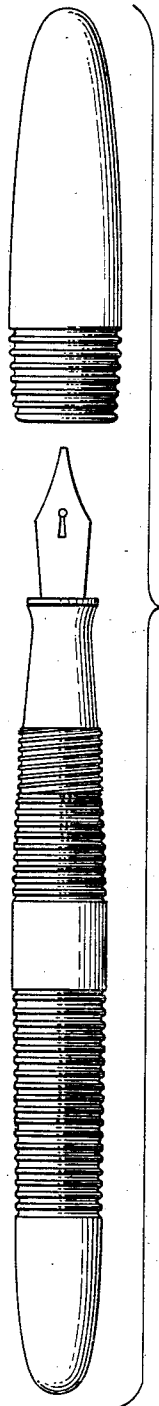
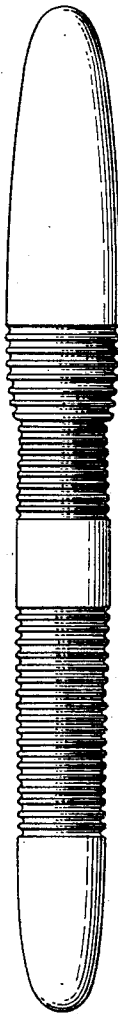

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John Vassos, a citizen of the United States, residing at Silver Mine, in the county of Fairfield and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is an exploded elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is an elevational view of the same with the cap in a closed position.
