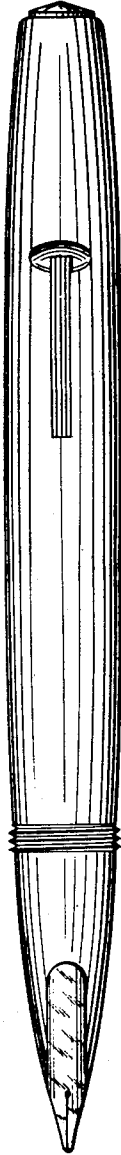

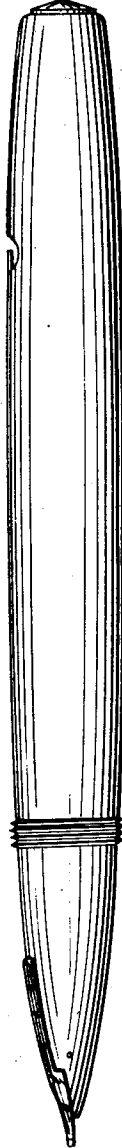

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN BARREL

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Charles K. Lovejoy, a citizen of the United States, residing at Needham, in the county of Norfolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen Barrel, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen barrel including the pen point showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevation of the same; and  
Figure 3 is a bottom plan of the same.

It is a characteristic feature of the design that the face of the barrel includes the whole length and convexity of the pen point and thereby has continuity to the extreme end of the pen point.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen barrel, substantially as shown and described.
