

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN AND PENCIL CLIP

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Karl Weisser, a citizen of Germany, residing at Union City, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen and Pencil Clip, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen and pencil clip showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevational view.

Figure 3 is a top plan view of the clip.

Figure 4 is a cross sectional view taken on the

line 4-4 of Fig. 1.

Figure 5 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen and pencil initial clip showing my new design, the initial plaques having been removed.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen and pencil clip, substantially as shown and described.
