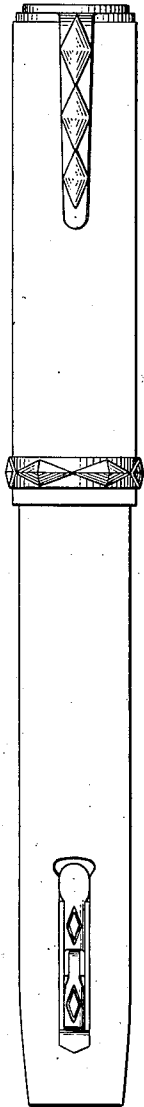
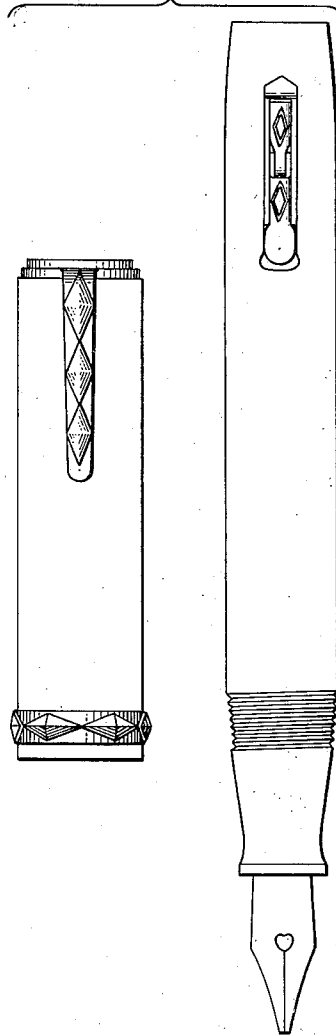

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Gabriel Larsen, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is an elevation showing the design as it appears when the cap is applied to the pen.

Fig. 2 is a view showing the design as it appears when the cap is removed from the pen.
