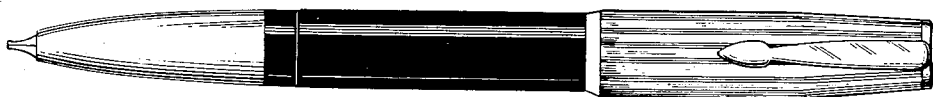
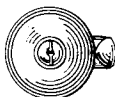

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

Arthur Winter, Weehawken, N. J.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur Winter, a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of Weehawken, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented the new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design, the cap thereof being removed from the writing point end and disposed on the barrel end; and

Figure 2 is a top end view of the fountain pen shown in Figure 1.

The essential feature of my design resides in ornamenting the upper end of the barrel with a color in contrast with the color of the writing point end of the barrel and the cap in a manner and of the type as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, as shown and described.
