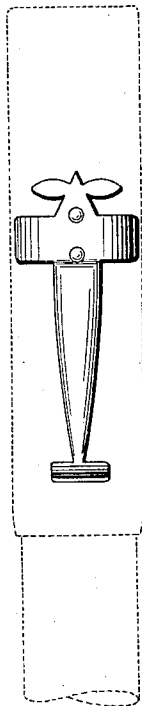

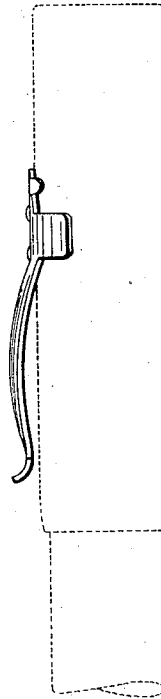
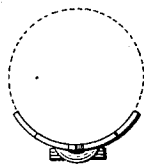

JULIUS L. SCHNELL, OF ARLINGTON, NEW JERSEY.

DESIGN FOR A PEN CLIP OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

Application filed June 1, 1927. Serial No. 22,269. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JULIUS L. SCHNELL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Arlington, in the county of Hudson and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pen Clip or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In said drawing:

Fig. 1 is a front view of the clip, the cap and body of the pen or pencil being indicated in broken lines;

Fig. 2 is a view taken at right angles to Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is a top plan view.
