

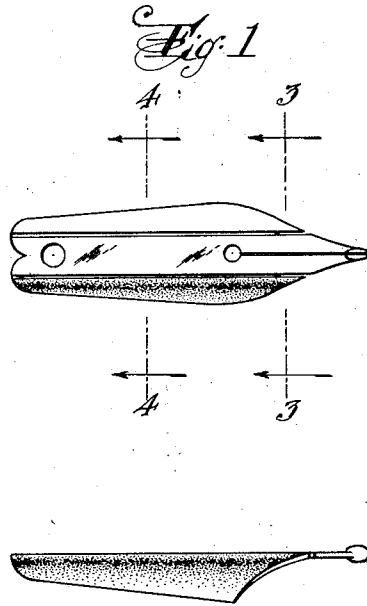

## DESIGN FOR A PEN NIB

Norman E. Weigel, Short Hills, N. J.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Norman E. Weigel, a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of Short Hills, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pen Nib, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof:

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a pen nib showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the pen nib, and

Figures 3 and 4 are enlarged transverse vertical sectional views on the lines 3—3 and 4—4 of Figure 1, respectively.

The essential features of my design for a pen

nib reside in the flat top panel with longitudinal grooves on both sides of said panel.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pen nib, as shown and described.
