To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Ned D. Fish and Lynn P. Martin, citizens of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing our new design with the writing end covered which would present substantially the

same appearance when viewed from any angle in elevation; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the same with the writing end exposed.

The dominant feature of our design resides in the cap shown in full lines.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen, substantially as shown and described.
