DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George C. Holt, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a foun-

tain pen in a closed position embodying my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view of the same pen with the cap positioned on the end of the barrel portion opposite to that of the writing point end.
